NFPA 1999 Standard, 2003 Edition



Outdoor Outfits is proud to announce that Underwriters Laboratories has CERTIFIED our NFPA series of jackets to the new NFPA 1999 Standard, 2003 Edition.

The new NFPA 1999 Standard, 2003 Edition has some major improvements:

1. Breathability Requirement (Total Heat Loss - THL) – THL measures heat and moisture released through all of the component fabric layers of the garment (shell and lining). Garments with a high THL performance are more comfortable in hot, humid conditions.

2. Spray Rating Requirement – This requirement measures how water beads on the surface of the outer shell. This would enhance the garment's ability to shed water & contaminants at the outer shell surface.

These standards specify requirements for apparel capable of signaling the user's presence visually and intended to provide conspicuity of the user in hazardous situations under any light conditions by day and under illumination by vehicle headlights in the dark.

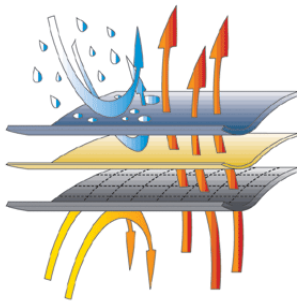
